



Located across the Cour du Cloître, the Prior's house - La Maison du Prieur -, built in the 13th century under the order of Cluny, is one of the final residences of a Cluniac prior which is still allowed to welcome guests.

Over the centuries, this building has undergone a number of architectural transformations to meet the needs of its successive occupants, including the Bernese bailiffs between 1536 and 1798, before becoming the Musée du Vieux Romainmôtier in 1922 with exhibition rooms showcasing the works of François Bocion and Ernest Bieler. For the history books, a very special wedding was celebrated within its walls on 3 December 1501. Philibert le Beau, Duke of Savoy, married Margaret of Austria, granddaughter of Charles le Téméraire.

In 1960, the writers and photographers Katharina von Arx and Freddy Drilhon took up residence and, with the assistance of the Fondation de Romainmôtier, restored every room to make it a quite an exceptional reception venue.

The Fondation de Romainmôtier acquired the residence in 2018, working in collaboration with Events & Saveurs, renowned caterers, to pursue the goal of ensuring that these rooms – steeped in history – were not merely consigned to history. You can savour local gastronomy here and visit all five floors to explore the building's mysteries.

With its heart beating to the hourly chimes of the Tour de l'Horloge – or clock tower – boasting a bell dating back to 1396, this timeless venue constantly reminds us that time continues to pass, in silence and contemplation... A moment of reflection ideal for taking a stroll, treating the taste buds or celebrating a special occasion... Come in! We are delighted to welcome you.
